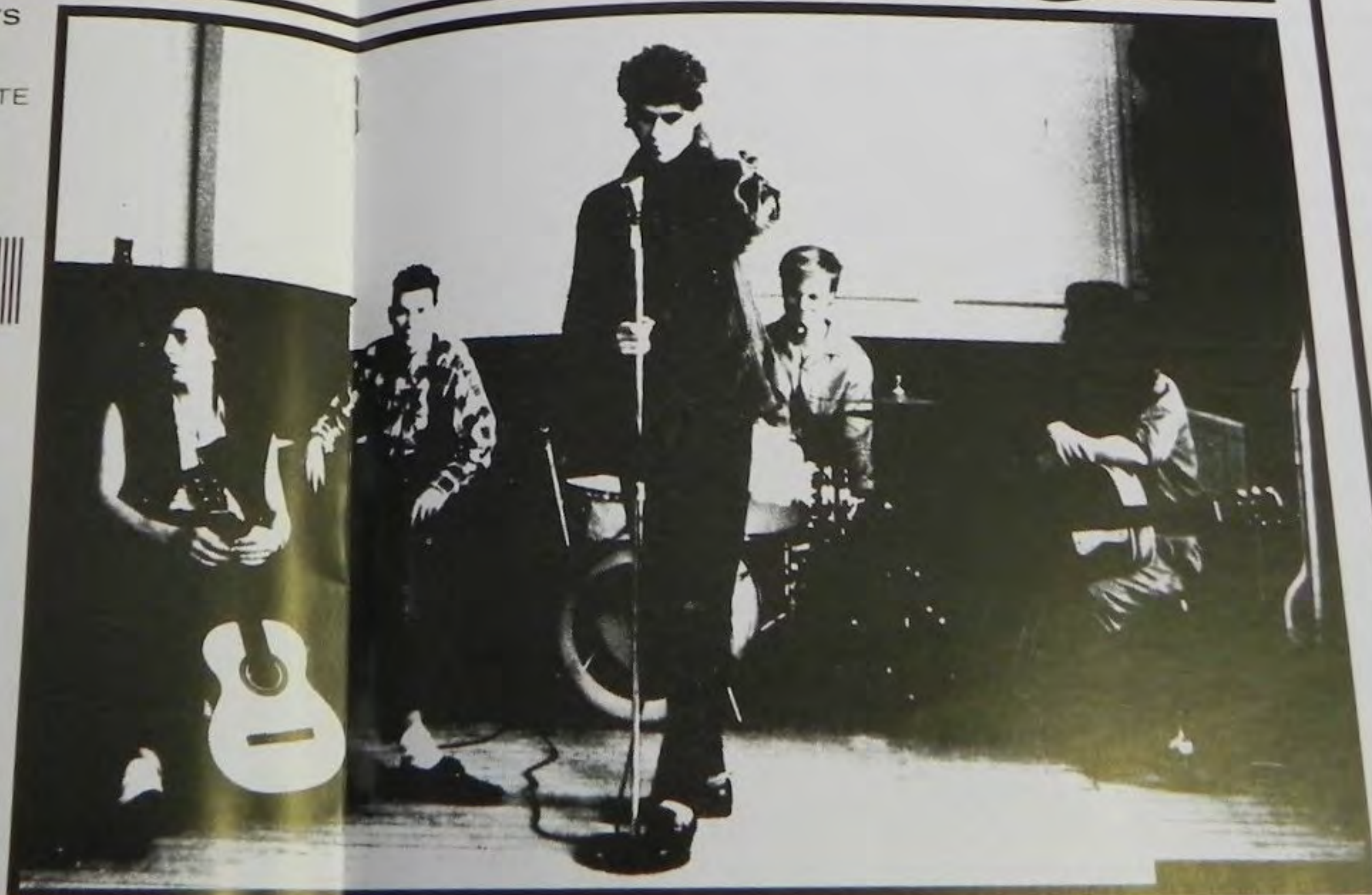

ZERRA I

Mountains and Water

ZERRA I were formed in early 1982 by PAUL and GRIMMO. As a duo they supported amongst others The Cocteau Twins, The Monochrome Set and U2 in Britain as well as doing European Tours with Siouxsie and the Banshees and The Cure.

During this time they released two singles, the latter being the highly acclaimed 'BANNER OF LOVE' which became one of the best selling 'Indie' records of 1983.

By this time they had already recorded one of the most repeated John Peel sessions ever. This was followed in 1984 with further sessions for Peel and David Jensen. Meanwhile they were still gigging and in 1983 did tours with both Peter Gabriel and Echo and the Bunnymen as well as many small club dates of their own.

By 1984 they had expanded to a 4-piece and a major record deal was signed with Phonogram. During that year they gigged quite extensively in between recording their album with Producer TODD RUNDGREN and doing a highly successful tour with BIG COUNTRY.

1985 will be quite a year for ZERRA I. A Radio 1 IN CONCERT is broadcast on January 26th; their latest single 'MOUNTAINS AND WATER' is released on February 1st; their first album entitled 'ZERRA I' is released on February 22nd...phew!...and that's just the beginning!
